

FRIENDSHIP UNITED METHODIST CHURCH BOARD OF TRUSTEES SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

The Board of Trustees of the Friendship United Methodist Church is pleased to inform you of our Scholarship Fund which is intended to assist students seeking post-secondary education. Such advanced training, whether it be academic, trade or technical, may be taken at any school approved by the Board of Trustees. The award will be presented in February of each year to the student(s) who has/have followed the outlined procedure and is/are chosen by the Board of Trustees based on the factors listed below:

Applicant must be enrolled in a Post-Secondary School (PSS) and be a student who has achieved second or fourth year standing as defined by the FUMC BOT. The applicant must have completed two semesters of PSS, shown on a transcript for second year consideration, and six semesters of PSS for fourth year consideration, AP credits earned prior to PSS are not considered in semester standing calculation. In addition, a first year of PSS-graduate study is also considered eligible. PSS includes trade or technical schools. All applicants must still be in school.

- Enrolled in a full course load (12 semester hours or equivalency per semester).
- Satisfactory grades (C-average, 2.0 grade-point average in most institutions).
- Member of Friendship United Methodist Church and has demonstrated faithful participation in the ministry and mission of the church (As determined by the Board of Trustees and the Pastor).
- Evidence of career goals.
- Work experience.
- Financial need.
- **COMPLETED APPLICATIONS WITH A COPY OF YOUR TRANSCRIPTS (OFFICIAL OR UNOFFICIAL) MUST BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY (NO EXCEPTIONS) AND MUST BE RECEIVED BY JANUARY 25, 2023.**
- **LATE AND INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
